Award includes: Large eagle statue engraved with the members name and Squadron, as well as a Life Membership in the SOA.

The award is given annually to a Most Deserving Son from one of the 56 Squadrons of the Department of Florida. It is given to a Son of AMVETS for his high standards of comportment to Sons ideals, his achievement, commitment, work ethic, and leadership shown throughout the year both at Squadron, Department, and Community level.

To nominate a Son from your Squadron, send your nominations to the SOA Department Commander, along with a cover letter explaining why and for what reason you are putting forward the name of the Squadron member. Include any Honors, Awards or other recognitions for Service to Veterans and Veterans causes, Americanism, Charitable Works, and Fundraising etc. both in the Post, Squadron and Community, including commitment to the Ladies Auxiliary. Include a good quality black and white or color photograph or an electronic file of the member nominated for inclusion on website.
